This is why a team of MGKF riders will participate in the [Pennsylvania Environmental Council's 2012 Environment Ride](#) on May 18-20. The full ride will run 170-miles from Elizabethtown to Center City, Philadelphia. A 1-day, 50-mile option, is available for riders on May 20 that will extend from French Creek State Park down the Schuylkill Trail to Fairmount Park.

Did you know?...

- The number of Philadelphia bike commuters has increased 76 percent between 1990 and 2006.
- Designated bike lanes reduce accidents by 30 percent.
- Local access to biking and walking trails reduces obesity.
- In 2008, Western PA's Great Allegheny Passage (Pittsburgh to DC connection) generated \$40.7M in revenue for local businesses and attributed to \$7.5M in wages.
- More than 100 miles of trails are in development through Southeastern PA.
