\$10,000 in prizes -- \$5,000 to one middle school and \$5,000 to one high school to enhance environmental programs.

Wawa, NBC10 and the environmental law firm of Manko, Gold, Katcher & Fox, LLP are looking for school classes, clubs or teams that currently have a worthwhile environmental community service school project, demonstrating a connection to their community. The criteria for projects includes, but is not limited to: establishing awareness of our natural and historic resources, and/or promoting community service that focuses on environmental and quality of life issues.

To qualify, schools must meet the following criteria:

- Complete and submit this application by Friday March 4, 2011. (Photographs and other supporting information are optional.)
- Be located in the following Delaware Valley counties: Pennsylvania Berks, Bucks, Chester, Delaware, Lehigh, Montgomery and Philadelphia; New Jersey -- Atlantic, Burlington, Camden, Cape May, Cumberland, Gloucester, Mercer, Ocean and Salem; Delaware – Kent and New Castle.

The proposals from schools who meet the criteria above will be reviewed by a panel of judges from: Wawa, NBC 10, Manko, Gold, Katcher & Fox, LLP, The Franklin Institute, Academy of Natural Sciences, the Fairmount Water Works Interpretive Center and representatives from Pennsylvania and New Jersey's Dept. of Environmental Protection and Delaware's Department of Natural Resources and Environmental Control. Close to the date of Earth Day (April 20, 2011), two schools (one high school and one middle school) will be selected from all the completed applications and award presentations will take place at each school.
