JONATHAN E. RINDE OF MANKO, GOLD, KATCHER & FOX, LLP TO SPEAK ON WETLAND PERMITTING AND REAL ESTATE DEVELOPMENT

Philadelphia, PA (February 4, 2008) – Jonathan E.
