## **Manko, Gold, Katcher & Fox, LLP, Supports the 2017 Environmental Law Forum**

McCabe rounded out Day 1 moderating the interactive Planners’ Roundtable on “*Pennsylvania’s Environmental Ethic: Where Are We Now?*”

Manko kicked off the second day of programming on Thursday, April 6 moderating a session on “*Federal and State Issues*.” He was joined by EPA Region III Counsel and DEP Chief Counsel, for look back at the most significant environmental developments in the state and region during 2016 and what can be expected in 2017. Concurrently, Silva moderated a panel on “*Managing/Organizing/Building A Litigation Case*,” that focused on navigating the complexities of litigation in the environmental arena. Attendees

learned the nuts and bolts of environmental litigation—including how to build, prosecute/defend, and manage a case from the initial stages through trial and appeal.
